*DOMINION* Blend will often suit general farm applications better than straight varieties because across individual farms and even individual paddocks different soil and nutrient profiles persist. Weather conditions are also unpredictable. Combining different grass varieties will increase the possibility of fantastic results.

### *DOMINION* is Fast & Persistent.

*DOMINION* incorporates one early maturing, one medium maturing and one late maturing perennial ryegrass variety for rapid germination and sustained vigour. For general pasture renovation or rejuvenation requiring rapid establishment, use *DOMINION* and you won't be disappointed. Use *DOMINION* in areas which demand rapid germination and establishment to minimise down time on new sowing or repair.

### Sowing.

*DOMINION* can be sown straight and is also incorporated into Advanced Seed's Pasture Booster, Pasture Stabilizer and Pasture Renovator.

In warm soils, seedling germination can be expected to take 5 to 7 days. For best results a seeding rate of 25-40kg per hectare is recommended depending on the application.

An application of 25kg of Nitrogen in the form of a starter fertilizer is also recommended.
