

Attribute Turf-Type Perennial Ryegrass

Features:

- Advanced generation cultivar
- Premium turf quality
- High in Endophyte content
- Very dense growth habit
- Good poa annua competition

Description:

Attribute Perennial Ryegrass achieved excellent turf quality ratings under different management levels and at diverse geographic locations.

Attribute shows very good traffic tolerance and density, even under heat stress.

Attribute greens up quickly in the Springtime with minimum seedhead formation and exhibits good suppression of Poa Annua. Attribute contains high endophyte for increased insect and stress resistance.

Geographical Adaptation:

Attribute is suitable for blends and mixtures with other advanced generation turf-type perennial ryegrass varieties as well as Kentucky Bluegrasses and also Fine & Tall Fescues.

Attribute Perennial Ryegrass is suitable for high quality permanent turf in cool areas, as well as for winter overseeding of dormant warm season grasses.

Recommended Seeding Rates:

New Establishment

4-5kg's / 100m²

Overseeding Dormant Warm Season Grasses

3-4kg's / 100m²

Turf Establishment Guidelines:

Adequate seed bed preparation is important in new turfgrass establishment as well as in overseeding.

Check soil pH and apply Advanced Seed's Starter Fertilizer prior to seeding.

Cool season grasses germinate best in the 60° to 85° (16° to 30°C) soil temperature range. Frequent light irrigation and/or seed starter mulch is required for optimum germination.

Germination should be visible within 14 days; complete turf establishment will take two to six months.

Mowing @ 20mm – 50mm is recommended.
