


Highland Bentgrass

- Highland Bentgrass (*Agrostis castellana*) was released in the 1930's and forms a dense turf that looks best when mowed at 15mm-20mm.
 - It has a dark blue ,grey colour and generally looks better in winter than other bentgrasses.
 - Highland bentgrass looks good in early Spring, but loses colour and becomes stemmy during November-February.
 - Highland bentgrass is a cultivar of colonial bentgrass that tends to have a slightly higher tolerance for heat and drought
 - It will stand as much traffic as creeping bentgrass and has disease problems similar to creeping bentgrass.

- Highland adapts to sun to partial shade and likes a well-drained ,moderate acidic soil.
